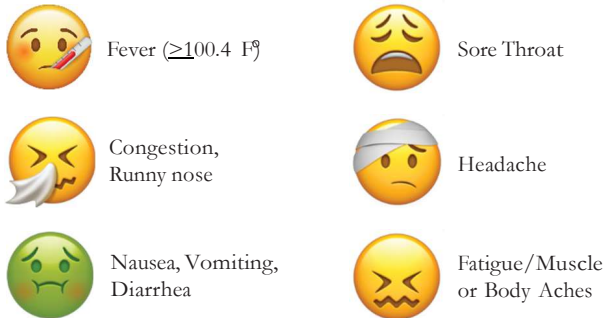
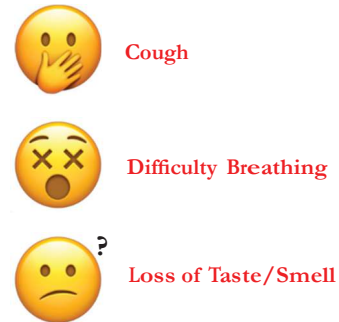


## Staff and Student Daily Screening and Decision Tree (for potential COVID-19 symptoms and exposure)

### Low-risk: General Symptoms




### High-risk: Red Flag Symptoms




### Daily Symptom Check:

Each morning before leaving home, employees should assess their health and parents/caregivers should assess their child's health.



1 Health care provider confirms alternative diagnosis for symptoms. A health care provider's note must be on file. COVID test not needed.  Return to CID after 24 hrs without fever and symptoms improving

2 **Negative** COVID test (lab-based).  Return to CID after 24 hrs without fever and symptoms improving

3 **Positive** COVID test.  
**OR**  
**No** provider visit or test.  **Return to CID only after 5 days since symptom onset and 24 hrs without fever (10 days if < 3 yrs old). Individuals must mask at CID for 5 additional days.**

### Close Contact Exposure: *Close contact is less than 6 ft for cumulative 15 minutes or longer*

Staff/Children who have had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 can attend school if they are not displaying symptoms. These individuals must mask at CID for 10 days from last exposure. Per current CDC guidelines, the individual is encouraged to be tested 5 days after last exposure, even if not displaying symptoms.
