SESSION 1 Future Scientists

Ages 6–12 • June 5–9, Mon–Fri, 9am–4pm • Cost: \$225 Full scholarships available

Campers will learn key concepts and apply them across multiple sciences including forensics, engineering, astronomy and zoology. They will participate in hands-on experiments and have multimedia learning opportunities. They will discover how sound effects are made and explore the many jobs on a movie set. Campers will create sets and design costumes in preparation for their culminating production on Friday!
